As per your response to Clarification N°2, we understand the Contractor should apply for VAT exemption from the government of Kenya once the Contract is signed (in order for suppliers to be able to invoice Contractor without VAT). Could you please clarify if the Employer will assist the Contractor in obtaining this VAT exemption? And kindly confirm that this VAT exemption will be for all input-VAT linked to the project (meaning: for imported goods & services and locally manufactured goods & services).	The Employer will provide the requisite support and assistance to the contractor during processing of the VAT Exemption. The VAT exemption will be for all in-put VAT linked to the project (for imported goods & services and locally manufactured goods & services)
2.	WHT We understand that withholding taxes will be deducted from IPC amounts & the Contractor will provide Employer with a WHT certificate. Kindly inform what WHT- rate will be withheld from IPC amounts? Will this WHT be a final tax or creditable against CIT? Kindly advice.	The application of the WHT will be discussed at the contract negotiation with the successful bidder. The WHT can be either paid to the Contractor or be deducted from IPC amounts and paid by the Employer on behalf of the Contractor, in which case the Employer will provide a WHT certificate to the Contractor. The WHT rate on construction/works contracts is 3% and is an advance payment of the Corporate Income Tax (CIT). The Bidders should check the laws of Kenya with regard to registration status of company and applicable Taxes.
3.	Lot1 – Bill 2.2: X993 Transverse R.C. Supports to Pipeline on Steep Cross-fall within the Mwache forest We understand from your answer 26 – set 03 of responses, that: - the design to be considered for the buried supports/piers to act as transverse supports is the same than the design for aerial sections. - Employer is requesting the Contractor to construct half of the piers for later installation of the second line of the Twin Mwache Trunk Main.
